Initial Approval Criteria:

Coverage may be approved if all of the following are met:

- Diagnosis of molluscum contagiosum; AND
- Must be prescribed by or in consultation with a dermatologist or pediatrician; AND
- Patient is 2 years of age or older; AND
- Must have one of the following:
 - An adequate trial of conventional therapy (cryotherapy or curettage) with an inadequate response or significant side effect/toxicity; OR
 - o Patient has concomitant bacterial infection; OR
 - Patient has severe symptoms of itching or pain; OR
 - Patient is immunocompromised; OR
 - Risk of disease spread (e.g., school, daycare, etc.); AND
- Dose does not exceed 2 applicators per treatment every 3 weeks; AND
- If applicable: Trial and failure, intolerance, or a contraindication to the preferred products as listed in the medical drug list

Renewal Criteria:

Coverage may be renewed if all of the following are met:

- Patient continues to meet the Initial Approval Criteria; AND
- Absence of unacceptable toxicity; AND
- Patient has shown response to treatment evidenced by reduction in number or size of lesions but with some remaining; AND
- It has been at least 3 weeks since last application and patient has not exceeded 4 treatments

Length of Authorization:

4 treatment cycles per infection (max of 8 applicators for approval duration)
